If you are not using a paint and material cost accounting program to determine the cost of paint and materials, you are losing thousands of dollars!

The difference between the allowances based on a dollar figure per paint hour and the allowances generated and justified through the use of a valid Paint and Materials Cost Accounting Program are so great that the difference can only be labeled as abuse!

The NJ Department of Banking and Insurance issued Bulletin 07-20 in 2007 stating that insurers are expected to provide repair allowances that are sufficient to restore damaged vehicles to their pre-accident condition and strongly recommended that insurers use one of the paint and material cost accounting programs to calculate the cost of paint and materials. Bulletin 07-20 further warned insurers that the Department would be watching and they would be expected to justify their allowances.
